### Please read the following before completing the back of this page and submitting your unit's reservation.

1. The first step to joining us at summer camp is to indicate that you will be attending Camp Ma-ka-ja-wan by reserving your campsite and putting a deposit down for the number of attending participants for the dates you will attend. To secure your dates, you must pay your unit's initial site fee and per-person deposit.
2. If your unit registers more participants than you initially account for on this form, their initial deposit will be paid upon their registration. If your unit's final registration is lower than you initially account for on this form, the money already deposited will be put towards your final registration balance.
3. **The campsite fee is strictly for your campsite. It will not be applied toward additional fees accrued while at camp.** It is non-refundable and non-transferable to other/future events or activities. Each unit must pay the campsite fee. Units that share the same charter organization and who will be sharing a site must only pay one site fee.
4. Our campsite locations and capacities are indicated on pages 3 and 4. If your unit has less than 50% of the site's capacity, we reserve the right to assign another unit to use the areas of the campsite that are available or reassign your unit to a site that better accommodates the number of paid participants in camp for your week.
5. Camp fees and per-person deposits are non-refundable as we encourage units to transfer fees to another Scout from the unit who is attending camp. However, the Northeast Illinois Council will address each situation in which a written refund request is received and strive to be as fair as possible. All refunds will be credited to the unit's camp bill, and the unit will be responsible for refunding fees to their Scouts or adults.
6. For the 2024 Camping Season, Camp Ma-ka-ja-wan's campsite fee and per person deposits are:

**\$75** per unit, per site (A, B, or C)

**plus**

**\$10** per participant (Youth and Adult)

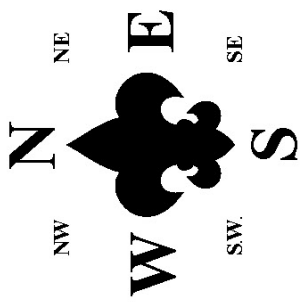
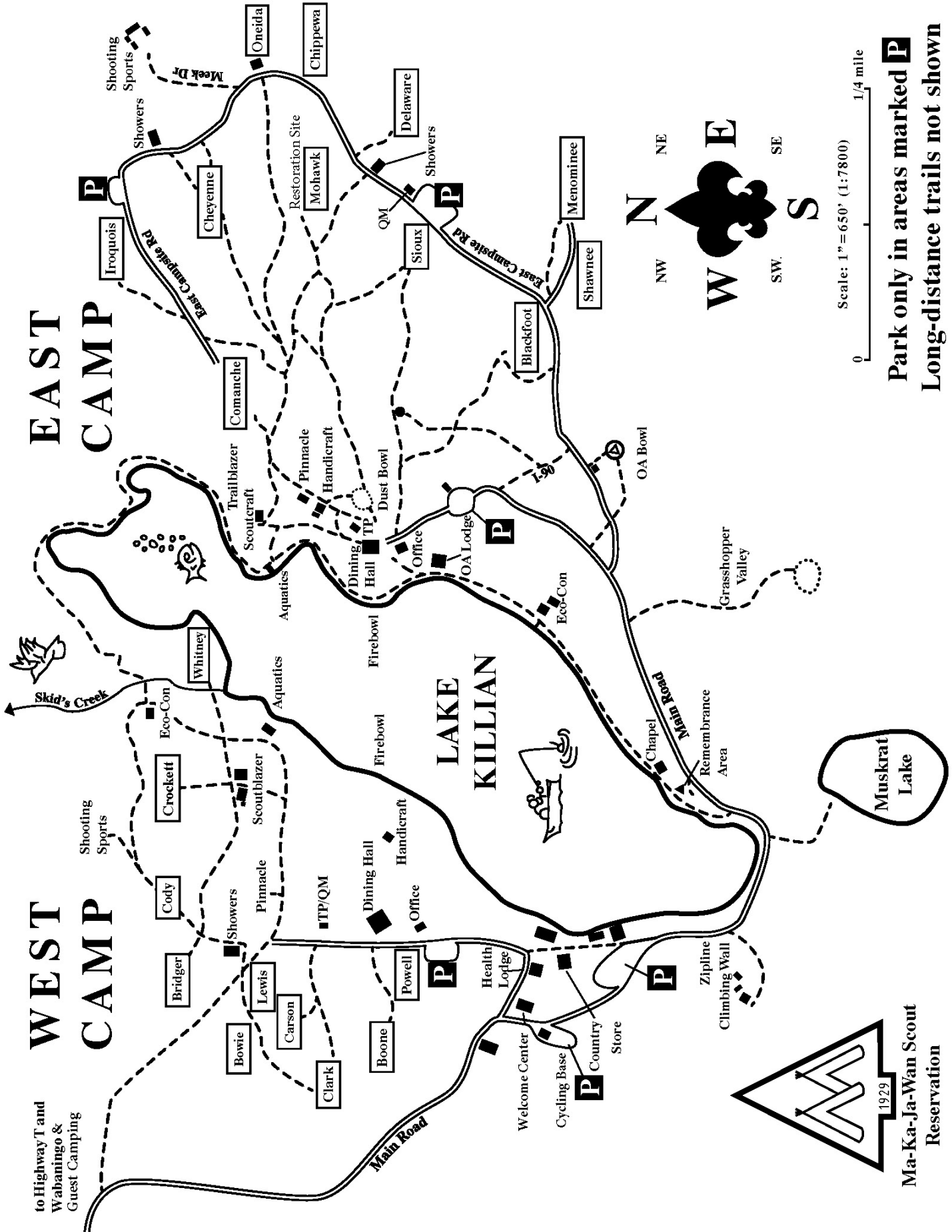

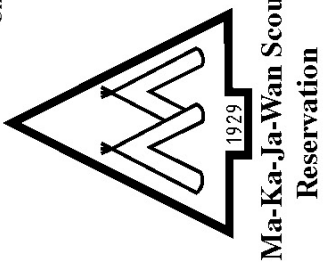
