Lodging on camp property:

Due to recent changes in National BSA policy, lodging on camp property will be more restrictive than in years past. Under the new policy:

- All overnight adults *must* be paid and registered with the BSA in a functional role (i.e. MB counselors do not count anymore).
- All overnight adults *must* have a current and valid YPT certificate.
- All overnight adults *must* have part A & B of the BSA AHMR form and Part C if they stay more than 72 hours.
- Staff quarters are off-limits to *all* alumni. No couch surfing, no hanging out, *no* exceptions, regardless of bed availability.

Representatives from the Northeast Illinois Council would like to remind you of the following:

- Reservations will be handled by Reservation Director Sam Dummer and Program Assistant Debi Geiger. You must coordinate with them if you wish to stay on property overnight.
- Attendees at the 95th anniversary event who have not coordinated with Sam and Debi ahead of time will not be allowed to camp on property.
- Camping on property will be limited to Gilwell Field, Jack Pine, and Birch campsites in the Wabaningo area of camp.
